REMARKS or REVISED DESCRIPTION: The station and both RMs were recovered in good condition. NGS PID for this mark is LZ1875. From Pikes Creek and the intersection of Rt. 118, follow Rt. 29 north for 4.1 mi., then left onto Sorber Mtn. Road (T677) for 1.3 mi., bear left at the Y-fork and continue on Sorber Mtn. Road for 0.65 mi., then left onto T762 for 0.45 mi. to a gate across the start of a dirt/gravel woods road, then WSW on the switchbacking woods road for 0.6 mi. to the ridge (N41°22'46" W076°06'45"), and finally E along a dim trail for 0.4 mi. to a small knoll and the station on the left. Station is approximately 6 ft. WNW of the remains of the rock cairn, 14 ft. N of a 12 in. diameter oak tree, and 9 ft. SSW of a 5 in. diameter maple tree. Azimuth mark was not observed from the station.
